Errors on entry blanks: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms whomever may make such errors and no entry fee will be refunded in event such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

The show site will be open to exhibitors at 7:00 a.m. Consult judging program for time of judging.

A \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee and a Recording Fee of 50 cents will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 14, Section 2.)


