**A RECORDING FEE** of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any AKC licensed or member club show, obedience or rally trial. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

**TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES** cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Instructions on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable. NO ENTRY shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

**ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FEES.** Postdated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. NHOC will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

**ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS** are the owner's responsibility. Refund of entry fee will not be made if such error is disclosed after the trial closing date.

**ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED** for dogs that are absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition.

**THE TRIAL WILL BE OPEN** from 7:30 A.M. TO 5 P.M. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. All dogs must be on leash or crated while on the show site (both indoors and outdoors) except when being judged.

**ONE ADMISSION** will be allowed for each dog entered. Consult judging program for time of judging.

**JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS.** Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
