Please consult the AKC *Regulations for Agility Trials* for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower or higher height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 24C" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether the dog has a valid jump height card or if the dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include the dog entered on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that a copy of a dog's jump height card be submitted with an entry form or show it at check-in; although exhibitors are required to have the official form/card with them at the trial to present upon request.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to English Cocker Spaniels fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the AKC or that have AKC Limited Registration, Indefinite Listing Privileges (ILP or an AKC Canine Partners listing number. Wherever the word “dog” is used it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place **indoors** on a **turf** surface. Ring size will be 100' x 100' without obstructions. Electronic timers will be used.

[Phone 614-894-4304] No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. **Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Post-dated, re-deposited, or returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a **\$35** collection fee to the amount of each re-deposited or returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

Please provide an e-mail or a self-addressed stamped envelope if you would like to be notified before closing that your entries have been received.

Maximum of 10 dogs are allowed in each envelope. Entry method is First Received.

Please be sure to have your e-mail address printed clearly on entry form. After closing date final confirmation and judging schedule will be sent out via e-mail.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

ECSCA is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of **20** runs per day will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary by March 12, 2021, 6 pm. Any request to withdraw that is received by Monday, April 5, 2021 6pm (Eastern) will only be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by April 5th, will receive a full refund. [We will shred your check.]

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

A warm-up area, consisting of one regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows for 1st-4th place:

PRIZES: Club reserves the right to make prize substitutions of equal or greater value in the event a specific prize listed is not available. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - none will be mailed.

A MACH/PACH rosette and MACH/PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PACH. [Please contact the Trial Secretary if your dog could possibly earn a MACH or PACH either day.](#) [All participants will get a custom tumbler for each dog entered created by Aurum.](#)

[A special rosette is offered by the English Cocker Spaniel Club of America, Inc.](#) through the generosity of several donors, to each dog or bitch completing an AKC title (Conformation, Obedience, Rally, Agility, Tracking, Field, or Hunting). Rosettes will be sent to the owner of record when the ECSCS has received confirmation notice from AKC 6-8 weeks after this National.

Each day we will offer HIT Veteran, HIT Regular, HIT preferred and HIT Champion. We will offer an overall for the two days. The daily HIT Regular/HIT Veteran/HIT Preferred/HIT Champion is awarded to the team that qualifies in standard and jumpers that day. In the case of tie scores (i.e. 2 dogs with a score of 200 total) the tie will be broken by the dog with the fastest (most) combined yards per second.. All Standard and Jumpers with weaves qualifying scores in Novice, Open, Master or Excellent are eligible. Premier qualifying scores are NOT included.

The overall HIT/HIT Veteran/HIT Preferred is awarded to the team that qualifies in standard and jumpers both days. In the case of tie scores (i.e. 2 dogs with a score of 400 total) the tie will be broken by the dog with the fastest (most) combined yards per second.. All Standard and Jumpers with weaves qualifying scores in Novice, Open, Master or Excellent are eligible. Premier qualifying scores are NOT included.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The English Cocker Spaniel Club of America, Purina Farms and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The English Cocker Club of America reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the English Cocker Spaniel Club of America or any official thereof. All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and **must include the Agreement and Rules**.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Handlers may opt to run dogs measuring 22 inches and lower entered in regular classes in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Preferred dogs must run in their measured height division. Only dogs measuring into the 24 inch class may enter the 24 inch class. All others wishing to jump 24 inches must enter 24C.

Pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited on the trial grounds.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

AVMA Statement: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

No bitches in season permitted in the building.

Effective June 1, 2018 ALL dogs may enter Premier Standard and Premier Jumpers. The Master level requirement has been removed.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at <http://www.akc.org/rules/>.

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Indoor crating space will be available. The trial site requires a tarp to be placed on the floor underneath your crates. Crates may be left overnight; however the ECSCA, Roberts Centre and its agents, employees, etc will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.. A committee member will have the right to consolidate crating as needed.

PLEASE DO NOT PARK REACTIVE DOGS NEAR THE ENTRANCES !!

Dogs are not allowed to relieve themselves on any building or landscaping.

Anyone not cleaning up after their dogs will be removed from trial with no refunds.

Dispose of all pet waste OUTSIDE in the containers provided.

- Exhibitors and Guests accept personal liability with respect to any claim made in respect to any damage or injury caused by their dogs or dogs in their possession.
- If it is necessary to rescue a dog from a parked car on the show grounds, the club will not be responsible or liable for any damage to the car involved.
- All crates must be on a solid type of matting that won't allow liquids or other substances to seep through on to the floor.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all times, when on the grounds.

ENTERING A MIXTURE OF REGULAR AND PREFERRED CLASSES WITHIN THE SAME TRIAL WEEKEND – MULTIPLE JUMP HEIGHTS WITHIN THE SAME WEEKEND

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee. Refunds will not be issued for less than \$10 and will be considered a donation to the club.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in agility trials. The club will offer refunds for bitches that come into season after the closing date. Refunds [100%] will be issued provided written certification from a veterinarian is submitted on clinic letterhead prior to the start of the trial.

Injured dogs. The club will offer refunds for dogs injured after the closing date. Refund will be 50% of entry fees paid for the injured dog provided written certification from a veterinarian is submitted on clinic letterhead prior to the start of the trial.

ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show. Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed. Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board). Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used. Food/treats are not allowed in the ring

FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring. A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

IMPORTANT CRATING INFORMATION

Crating rules for agility are below. Rules will be enforced. Crating will be near the agility ring. Please keep your area clean! Please see the agility specific rules below.

- Crates must be on plastic that the exhibitor provides...
- Exhibitors can leave our stuff overnight and should plan to move their belongings at the completion of Monday's trial.
- Soft sided crates can be used in the agility crating area.
- No private exercise pens, 3x3 puppy pens or mats allowed.
- No electricity is provided around the agility area. If you wish to have electricity you need to purchase a reserved grooming spot. See the conformation premium for details.
- **No grooming allowed in the agility crating area.** If you need to groom your dog, you are expected to purchase a grooming spot or use the free grooming space (no electric). See the conformation premium for details.
- If you wish to leave your dogs overnight in the building, you are expected to purchase a grooming spot or crate in the limited free grooming spots. See the conformation premium for details.

Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
