COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS

These trials will not be open to the general public.

All Exhibitors, Handlers, Owners, Judges, and Event Staff MUST complete the COVID-19 Waiver and COVID-19 Self Declaration which will be sent with the Judging Program and turn these documents in at Check-In on the first day they are on the grounds. Minors must have their own signature as well as the signature of a parent or legal guardian on the documents. Exhibitors will NOT be checked in or allowed to compete if these documents are not submitted.

Masks will be required at all times on event grounds except while actively working a dog on a track or when you are in your own personal vehicle. Face masks must be worn so that they cover the mouth and nose. Please bring your own face masks and wear them at all times.

Everyone will be required to follow social distancing guidelines. This means maintaining six feet of distance from others and not congregating trackside or in any other area.

DIRECTIONS TO TEST HEADQUARTERS

From I-65 Southbound - Take Exit 91 for US-31W North/KY-61 North. Turn left onto KY-61 North/US 31W North/East Dixie Ave. Approx 0.7 miles to headquarters.

From I-65 Northbound - Take Exit 91 toward US-31W/KY-61 Elizabethtown/Hodgenville. Merge onto Western KY Pkwy. Turn left onto US-31W North/East Dixie Ave (signs for Elizabethtown. Approx 1.4 miles to headquarters.

DRAWING FOR TRACK ORDER Drawing for VST track order will take place at 10 AM EDT at Test Headquarters First tracks will run when ready.

No dogs are to be allowed to be "off lead". Due to the changing nature of the fields being used by clubs for tracking tests and the increased population at these sites by the general public, dogs shall be "on lead" at all times on any area of the tracking site.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Entries must be made on an Official American Kennel Club Entry Form, signed by the actual owner or duly authorized agent and accompanied by appropriate entry fee (separate checks for multiple entries) in US Funds. Please make checks payable to Mid-Kentucky Kennel Club. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Collection fees will be added to the amount of each returned check. Entries will be acknowledged if a legible email address is included on the entry form. Do not send entries by any method which requires a signature for acceptance. *Cancellation of entries must be made in writing and received prior to the stated close of entries.*

A worker draw will be used for this test in accordance with the parameters set forth in Chapter 1, Section 17d of the Tracking Regulations and as established by Mid-Kentucky Kennel Club and published in the August 2013 Meeting minutes. Two tracks will be set aside for workers at this test.

In accordance with the AKC Obedience Regulations, entries shall be accepted up until the official closing date even though the advertised limit has been reached. A random drawing of all entries with preference given to dogs which have not previously earned the applicable AKC tracking title to determine catalog order will take place on March 22, 2021, at 7:00 PM EDT at 421 E Dixie Ave, Elizabethtown, KY, and the public is invited. When the limit has been drawn, all remaining entries shall be drawn in the same manner and assigned a position on the alternate list. In the event the advertised limit is not reached, entries will be assigned catalog numbers in the order in which they were received and a draw will not take place.

All entries will be notified of their entry status and a Judging Program will be emailed and/or mailed to the entrant as soon as practical after entries close and the draw is completed. Should you not receive such notification within a reasonable amount of time, please contact the Event Secretary.

Entry fees will not be refunded for any reason other than for alternates who do not run and entrants replaced by an alternate at the test. Entry fees will be refunded within seven (7) days following the test date if an SASE has been provided by the entrant; otherwise, the checks will be shredded. In the event an accepted entry withdraws prior to the test date, the event secretary shall contact alternates according to their placement on the alternate list and upon notification, said alternate shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

The Mid-Kentucky Kennel Club, its officers and representatives, the Event Chair/Secretary, Committee and the owner(s) of the Event site(s) assume no responsibility for loss of, damage to, or injury sustained by spectators or exhibitors, their property and/or their dogs and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
