Entries must be received by 6:00 pm Wednesday, September 22 2021, after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$20 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. <u>Novice class</u>: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards with competition present in Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licenses or member show.

**Open class**: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards with competition present in Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licenses or member show.

<u>Master class</u>: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition the calendar for this class will be November 1 -October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the followingyear.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.
