Per AKC regulations, entries automatically close when limits have been
reached, even if this occurs before the official closing date. However, the club
will maintain a waiting list up until the official closing date of October 27, 2021
and will accept entries up to that date. If an entry is withdrawn prior to that date
and is replaced by a wait-listed entry, the full entry fee for the withdrawn entry
will be refunded. **All Collies have Priority for entry, so entry status for other
breeds will not be determined until the trials close.**

Obedience and Rally Classes requiring jumps will be judged by jump height.

Rally: Ascending order on Friday morning, starting with 4", and Descending
order on Friday afternoon, starting with 16".

Rally classes will run in the order Master – Excellent (B and A) – Advanced (B
and A) – Intermediate – Novice (B and A).

Obedience: Ascending order on Saturday, starting with 4", and Descending
order on Sunday, starting with 36".

Obedience classes will run in the order Utility A – Utility B – Open B – Open A –
Novice B – Novice A – Beginner Novice B – Beginner Novice A.

OC MATCHES FRIDAY and SATURDAY

IECC will hold an OC obedience match on Friday, November 12 and on
Saturday, November 13, to start one-half hour after the conclusion of judging for
each day. \$10 for 10 minutes in the ring. Sign-up sheets will be available at the
trials.

You may use toys in the ring, but not food. The matches are limited to dogs that
are entered in obedience classes in the trials.

TRIAL REGULATIONS

ENTRY INFORMATION: Entries close at P O Box 2259, Airway Heights, WA 99001 at 5:00 pm, **Wednesday, October 27, 2021** or when limits are reached. Fees must accompany entries. Canadian Exhibitors **MUST** make all checks and/or money orders payable in U.S. funds. All checks and money orders should be made payable to **Inland Empire Collie Club (IECC)** and mailed to Trial Secretary, Barb Benner, PO Box 2259, Airway Heights, WA 99001. **Fed Ex & Hand Deliveries ONLY To:** Barb Benner, Trial Secretary, 15407 W Tepee Rd, Spokane, WA 99224.

AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB RECORDING FEE: A RECORDING FEE will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.)

No entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telephone, telegraph and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms, and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side or attached page are NOT ACCEPTABLE; see Obedience Regulations. Ch. 1, Section 3. The Club assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent, or if the dog is entered in a class in which it is not eligible to compete. THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. The Secretary will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Entry fees will be fully refunded for BITCHES THAT COME IN SEASON after the closing date, provided that written notice is given to the Trial Secretary PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF JUDGING for the day. REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change, bitches in season or cancellations made prior to entry closing will be mailed to the Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE TRIAL.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

JUDGING: No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those regularly entered in the Trial. DO NOT BRING ANY DOGS THAT ARE NOT ENTERED. There is no provision for unentered dogs. The judging will start promptly as specified in entry confirmation. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging. The Club will not be responsible and is not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class; it is not the responsibility of the ring steward to locate any dog, its owner or its agent when the dog's presence is needed in the judging ring. Judges will NOT wait for any dog holding up a class.

TRANSFERS: Transfers from one class to another are allowed at these trials; the request for a transfer must be in writing and must be presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial. Transfers will be accepted prior to the day of the trial, and must be in writing (e-mail meets the requirement).

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS: Entries will be acknowledged upon receipt if a valid email address is provided with entry. If the exhibitor provides an e-mail address, it is assumed that the exhibitor is willing to receive entry confirmation and judging program by e-mail after entries close, UNLESS a postal confirmation is specifically requested. If no e-mail address is provided, they will be sent by postal mail. Should exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, please contact the Trial Secretary at agilmals@gmail.com or (509) 244-2332.

LOSS OR DAMAGE: The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this Trial. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable disease, and have appropriate vaccinations.

AWARDS: Trophies and prizes will be awarded at the trial. No Award will be mailed.

CATALOGS

Trial catalogs may be pre-ordered with your entries for \$3.00; please mark the box on the entry form and add \$3.00 to your check. A limited number of catalogs will be available for purchase at the trial for \$5.00.

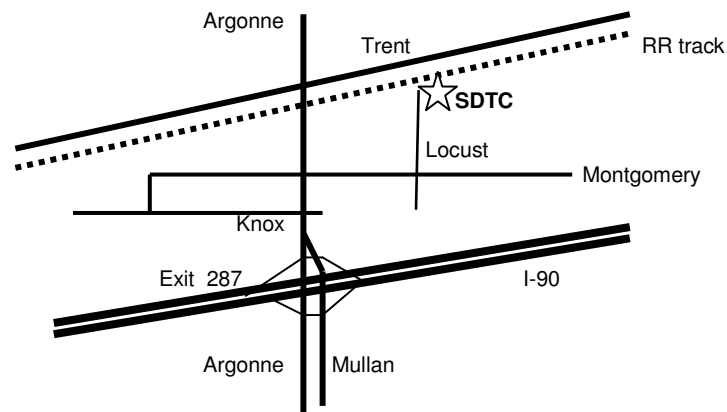

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE



Take I-90 to exit 287 (Argonne). Go north on Mullan (one-way, becoming Argonne two-way just north of the freeway).

Turn **RIGHT** on Montgomery.

Turn **LEFT** on Locust (one block past the traffic light at the Yoke's Fresh Market grocery store). There is no light at Locust.

Locust ends at the RR tracks; SDTC is on the right at the end of the street.

There is parking on the west and north sides of the club building, parallel along Locust and in the cul-de-sac, on the gravel on the **EAST (street) side** of Spokane Gymnastics, and in the lot behind Snap Fitness (just east of Yokes Fresh Market). **PLEASE DO NOT PARK ON THE ASPHALT ON THE NORTH (RR track side) OF THE GYMNASTICS BUILDING, EVEN THOUGH IT IS STRIPED FOR PARKING SPACES. THIS IS A TRUCK ROUTE FOR YOKES, and very large trucks must pass through.** There will be a place near the building where you may temporarily park to unload or load equipment and/or dogs. *Thank you for your cooperation.*

No overnight parking is available on show site. There is no charge for day parking.

Due to space limitations, there is no motor home parking available in the SDTC lot.

COVID-19 CONCERNS

Please read carefully the information below, AND the waiver statement on the adjacent page.

In order to comply with guidelines for reducing the spread of COVID-19, a number of normal trial procedures may be modified. **We are required to comply with whatever state and local requirements are in effect at the time of the event.** Because recommendations have been changing frequently, we do not know at this time what those requirements may be. They may include wearing masks while in the building. We will provide more information with final confirmations. **Please check your email regularly to make sure that you are aware of all communications regarding the trials!**

All staff and any participants are required to stay home if they are sick.

Access is limited to only necessary participants – NO spectators, vendors, guests or visitors. Participants that are minors may be accompanied by one adult.

Events must allow for social distancing and avoid high densities of people. It may be necessary to restrict access to the building in order to comply with this requirement.

At this time, we anticipate having limited indoor crating available for exhibitors; however, we may need to ask people to vacate their spaces or condense their gear once they are finished exhibiting, to make room for those entered in the classes that are scheduled later in the day. If it is necessary to eliminate indoor crating because of COVID-19 restrictions, exhibitors will be informed prior to the trials.

Please be aware that we want to keep everyone as safe as possible, while still having the opportunity to have fun with our dogs!

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. By attending these events, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this Obedience Trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Obedience Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or trial secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Obedience Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this Obedience Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.
