First entry of each dog ..... \$20.00  
Second and subsequent entries of same dog same day ..... \$12.00  
Entry fees include \$3.50 AKC recording fee per first entry, \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog same day.

Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. The Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry form or left blank by the owner or agent of the owner.

**GSDOC is accepting online entries** through the AKC Online System. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be designated as follows: Online entries: 20% (66), paper entries 80% (264), 330 runs per day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly. Paper entries received within the first 24 hours must include postage or be metered. Entries must be delivered by multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL.

**Entries not on official AKC agility entry forms** or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC agility entry form are invalid. In addition, entries will not be accepted without fees or signature. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Move-up must be made on or before Monday, January 10, 2022, 6:00 PM MST.

**Illegible or incomplete entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not accompanied by the correct fees, or a returned check, or a postdated check do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their future entries being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

**Owners are responsible** for any errors on entry forms regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be returned in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date. Duplicate entries will not be refunded if already processed.

**A maximum of 10 entries** per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

**GSDOC is offering a waitlist** to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing January 14, 2022, 5:00 pm MST. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the club's waitlist. All entries, including waitlisted entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to closing January 14, 2022, 5:00 pm MST. Any entries withdrawn that are received by November 11, 2021, 5:00 pm MST will be replaced by a first received waitlisted entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any waitlisted entry that does not move off the waitlist into the trial by January 14, 2022, 5:00 pm MST will receive a full refund.

**Entry fees will not be refunded** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. Female dogs that come into season after entries close and up to 30 min before the start of the trial, will receive a full refund of their entry fee minus a \$5.00 processing fee.

**No entry fees** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the club, trial committee or trial secretary.

**Golden Spike Dog Obedience Club** may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against GSDOC, the trial secretary, or any officials thereof.

## JUDGING INFORMATION

**Check-in** will begin at 7:00a.m. First dog on the line at 8:00a.m. all days. Electronic timers, rubberized contacts and safety jumps will be used.

**Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. Neither the club nor the Trial Secretary have any obligation or responsibility to provide a service through a public address system, or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

\*\*\***FAST** class walk thru will be nested for all levels to walk/run together.

**Judges Briefing** may be done over a ring speaker so exhibitors do not have to come into the ring for briefing to maintain social distancing.

**Exhibitors** in all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog during a walk thru period held prior to the start of the class. The walk thru is restricted to handlers entered in that class.

**Warmup area** consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warmup area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

**Set up** for the trial will be allowed Thursday evening January 27<sup>th</sup> from 5:30 PM till 7:00 PM. GSDOC would appreciate any help received setting up for the trial.

### **Measuring and Height Card Information**

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

### **Simplified Jump Height Card Process**

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs to Be Measured List.

### **Dogs Eligible to Enter**

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible and neither are aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds. After the close of entries, a dog, which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler, may be moved to the Novice "B" class. A request must be submitted to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of EACH trial and must state the reason and justification for the move. A dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. (Chapter 1 Section 21). For exhibition only will be offered at these trials.

### **January 1, 2020 Rule**

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day. A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms. (Chapter 5 Section 8). **FEO is offered at these trials.**

### **FIX AND GO ON (FNG)**

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

## RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place .....	Blue
Second Place.....	Red
Third Place.....	Yellow
Fourth Place .....	White
Qualifying Score .....	Dark Green

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH rosette and MACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH. A PACH rosette and PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their PACH. Please let the trial secretary know with your entry if you are close to attaining your MACH or PACH so we can celebrate with you.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: SAFETY, BEHAVIOR, LIABILITY

Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, at the discretion of the trial committee, may be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Golden Spike Dog Obedience Club and its agents, employees, trial secretary, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Golden Spike Dog Obedience Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Golden Spike Dog Obedience Club, Club officers and board members, Trial Secretary, or any official thereof.

**Golden Spike Dog Obedience Club** will not be responsible for the loss of/or damage to any dog entered and exhibited, whether the result of accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this trial is under the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler at all times. Golden Spike Dog Obedience Club, Club officers, board members, and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, their dogs, or property.

**All dogs must** be on leash at all times or otherwise confined when on trial/show grounds except when in the designated warmup area or competing on the course. (AKC leash restrictions March 2009, Weber County leash Ordinance 13-2-6A). Trial grounds are defined as the entire public area of Golden Spike Event Center.

**Volunteers** that work three or more classes will receive lunch provided by Golden Spike Event Center. **Personal food or sack lunches will not be allowed on premises** – Golden Spike Event Center rules. Golden Spike Event Center sells food on site. There are various restaurants and fast-food vendors within a short driving distance.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program<sup>SM</sup> may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
