Arrive 15 minutes before your assigned time to run and check in with the secretary. When it is your assigned time, you may check into the Soundness Check Table. Then you will proceed to the start line. Day of Event runs will run 12-1pm on each day. All Fun Runs will run 12-1pm also. These trials will run Concurrently

If entry limit is not reached, DOS entries will be accepted (12-1pm). Only hard copy entry forms with PayPal, cash or checks will be accepted for DOS entries. All entries must have an AKC number.

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

All dogs run at owner's sole risk.

Dogs must be one year of age or older on the day of the test. Each dog requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered. Dogs must have an AKC, PAL or Canine Partner registration number.

### *Site Specifics:*

This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs and water.

Our Fast CAT course is a permanent fence with 5' fencing.

\*Bitches in season will be refunded entry fees with a vet document that bitch is in season after closing less PayPal fees. If presented at inspection in season, entry fee refunded less PayPal fees. Dogs that are injured while doing Fast CAT will be eligible for a refund less PayPal fees. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "agreement" signature found on an official AKC entry form.

**No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or conditions, an act of God, a public emergency, or any other control of the club or its members or**

Gas powered machine with continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of plastic strips.  
An electric timing system will be used.

Any person, upon reasonable complaint, can be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC.

Children must be under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s) at all times.

A \$5.00 fine will be assessed on the owner or handler of any dog loose on the field not competing in the course in progress.

You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.

A return check fee of \$35.00 will be assessed for any check returned for insufficient funds.

We will be asking that everyone maintain Social Distancing. We will have hand sanitizer available if needed.

### **Refund Policy:**

There will be no refunds after the pre-entry close date.( April 15, 2021) Bitches coming in season after closing will be required to supply a statement from their vets that bitch is in season. Then send in writing for refund to [brylin17@windstream.net](mailto:brylin17@windstream.net).

All entries that use PayPal will have the PayPal fees deducted from refund fees.

The host club and Brylin Obedience Specialty School and its members will not be held responsible for any accidents at this event. All AKC Rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.

### **Day of Event Procedures:**

Please check in at the Secretary Desk without your dog when you arrive. A pre-assigned time will be assigned in conformation.

There will be 5 dogs on the Start Line at one time. You will have your Soundness Test complete at start line area. You will then go to the start line. Tell the Hunt Master the name of your dog and if you are running Trial 1 or 2 or Fun Run. Make sure that you have someone at the Catch Pen to catch your dog before entering the start box. If not, you will be asked to wait until someone is at the Catch Pen.

You can pick up your participation ribbons at the Score Desk. You may take a picture of your judge's sheet at this desk also. We ask that only 3 people wait at this desk to view score sheets.

You may pick your title ribbons up at the Secretary Desk.

Please do not talk with the Lure Operator during the event. He needs to focus on each dog that is running.

## **Day of Entries (12-1pm 15 dogs/ event)**

We will have entry forms available for you to fill out. We will ask that you please fill those forms out at your car. Return entries back to the Secretary Desk after you have filled them out. Day of Entry Fees are \$30/run. We accept cash, check and PayPal for payment.

## **Hours**

Events will Start at 9am. The grounds will be available at 8:30am Saturday and Sunday. Early acceptance for members of the field committee may begin one-half hour prior to these times.

## **Directions to Trial Event**

Directions: From East or West, take I-40 to 52 North. From Highway 52 take Exit 123 (King/Tobaccoville). At the top of ramp turn toward the city of King. Just past rail road tracks, turn left onto W King Street. After passing Fire Station, BOSS is at 416-D W King Street. (The far end of the building past the Rock Church.)

## **Awards**

The host club will give a light blue ribbon for a passing run. At each trial, BOSS will sponsor new title ribbons. You may pick up your Participation Ribbons from the Score Table. You may pick up your Title Ribbons from the Secretary Desk. Please do not bring your dog with you to the desks. No ribbons will be mailed.

## **Tips**

Walk your dog after each run and make sure that they have recovered before placing them in your car or truck and walking away.

Make sure that you come to the line with a secure collar. If your buckle collar is loose enough for them to slip out of, you can bet they will.

A \$5 fine for loose dogs at this event.

Make sure that you can let your dog loose when you get to the line. Do not have them in a harness and collar and etc.. by the time you got it all off, your dog is frustrated and so is everyone else waiting. No dangling tags on collars on the course. This is for your dog safety.

You are allowed to have a toy or food in your pocket but do not show to your dog until after they have crossed the finish line. Do not get upset if your dog does not want to be caught. They are enjoying the moment. Also do not get upset if your dog bites the lure bag. That is his reward

Make sure that you walk your dog really well. IF your dog relieves himself on the Course, that is not an NQ. It do add time to your MPH.

Do not stand your dog next to the fence so they can watch and bark. This is very distracting to the dog that is on the field

Do not yell ."GO" When you release your dog. Your dog has a tendency to return to you if you talk. I know this is hard when you are about as excited as your dog is on the course.
