ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating space will be available around the perimeter of the building. Please allow with sufficient space between so as to avoid distractions and to help with social distancing. NO CRATING PLEASE IN THE MATTED AREA BETWEEN THE OBEDIENCE RINGS AND THE RALLY RING, NOR WITHIN 15 FEET OF THE RINGS THEMSELVES.

Crates may be left overnight; however, the Fairgrounds and the three sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s) both in the building and on the grounds. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund on recommendation of the Trial Committee.

Route to the Events

From Interstate 10, take exit 199 and go due South on Monroe St. for 9 miles. The fairgrounds are located at the intersection of Monroe St. and Paul Russell Rd. (just 2 miles past the State Capitol).

Enter fairgrounds off Monroe St. at Fairgrounds sign.

The trials are all in Building 4, the second building on the right hand side of the road in. Parking on the road is for temporary unloading ONLY. All parking for the trials is on the Monroe St. Side of the buildings in the open field, or behind Building 4. Thank you for your cooperation!

Notice to Exhibitors

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform exercises safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children.

Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Each club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Each club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against any of the clubs or any official thereof. All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing in the ring.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. As such, the club will refund less \$5.00 per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate at least thirty minutes prior to trial start.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

All clubs do not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

(Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti- color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. 4. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience & Rally trials at the club's option. AGREEMENT

- A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class; or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made.
- Transfers from an "A" to "B" class at the same level are allowed provided the host club allows transfers. (When a club does not allow transfers, refer to Section 16b. Entry of Ineligible Dog.)
- The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit.
