## CONDITIONS

This trial will run under the rules governing a Flexible Format, the committee reserves the right to rearrange the running order of the stakes, and add/rearrange judges if conditions warrant. Entries limited to the number of dogs that can be run during daylight hours. Entries close when this limit is reached, even if this occurs prior to the closing date. A waitlist will be kept, and if a dog is pulled from the entry list, the first waitlisted dog will replace it.

Dogs may wear AKC approved tracking collars. Bitches in season may run during the last brace(s) either as by dog or paired with another female. Bitches who come into season at the time of the trial may run, with timely notification to the trial secretary so the brace can be dropped down in order.

Running orders will be emailed to the address included on entry form(s). To be assured of future delivery of premiums please e-mail the field trial secretary with request.

## COURSES, BIRDS AND PRIZES

Horseback handling will be permitted in all stakes except those designated as walking stakes. Horses will not be provided by the club for handlers, scouts or bird planters. ATVs allowed in all stakes.

Bobwhite quail, chukar and/or pheasants released in all stakes except puppy. A blank gun will be fired in all stakes except Open Puppy and Novice Walking Handler †. Gunners will fire for retrieving birds. Gun Dog stakes are retrieving. Limited stakes are non-retrieving. Stakes will be run on two courses, without bird fields.

Standard AKC ribbons will be awarded to all placing dogs.

**GROUNDS:** Please park all rigs on the gravel area, to prevent getting stuck and causing ruts if wet conditions exist. Horses and dogs may be staked out in the grassy areas. Horses may utilize the pipe corrals, please reserve for the judges' horses if they prefer. Remaining corrals may be utilized by contestants and club members.

**CAMPING:** Will be permitted on the grounds. Outhouses, non-potable water, and limited electric hookups available.

## SPECIAL STAKES

We will be offering two non-AKC sanctioned "fun" stakes. No AKC points shall be awarded for these events. Each stake will be judged off horseback and placements will be awarded with rosettes to placing dogs.

### JUDGES: Vicky Moore and Jean Carol

NEW! "Novice Walking Handler" stake for children and novice handlers to practice handling their dog.

- Each Novice handler will have one adult/seasoned "scout" to accompany, guide, and assist them during their run.
- Dogs are allowed to wear electric collars and wear more than 2 collars. Only adults may hold and utilize the remote for electric collars.
- This will be a walking stake with no horseback handling or scouting allowed, limited at 20 minutes in length.
- Single dog and handler stakes, no bracedmates.
- No blank guns or shotguns of any type will be utilized in this stake.
- Dogs are to establish point, and the handler is to flush the bird, and heel the dog off. Scouts may touch/collar or handle the dog at any point deemed necessary.
- Judging will base score off of the Novice's handling of the dog, not the dogs' performance.



To follow will be the **Senior Walking Gun Dog** open to any pointing dog over 10 years in age. Top four dogs will be called back to retrieve. Judging will be based on dogs' performance comparable to a Walking Gun Dog stake.
